Stay at home, follow health discipline to keep away Corona virus: AP Governor

Appeal by Governor Biswa Bhusan Harichandan to win the war against corona virus

Vijayawada, March 20: Hon'ble Governor of Andhra Pradesh Biswa Bhusan Harichandan appealed to people of the state to stay at home and follow all the precautionary measures as advised by the medical experts to avoid spread of novel Corona virus COVID-19.

The Governor appealed to people to avoid non-essential travelling and visiting places. He appealed to people to wash their hands frequently with soap or sanitisers and cover their faces with face masks in case they experience symptoms of fever, cough and cold. He asked people to keep the surfaces touched by hand clean, maintain social distancing, avoid gathering of more than ten people and take care of both elderly people and children at home.

The Governor said there is no need to be panic over Corona virus. He said in case any symptoms are noticed, people can contact the call centre and consult doctors at designated test centres set up by government immediately and follow their advise.

Governor Harichandan also appealed people to avoid visiting religious places, till the situation becomes normal or as advised by the authorities, from time to time.

He said by taking necessary precautions and following health discipline, we can win the war against Corona virus together and protect ourselves, our families, our society and our nation.
