Make Janata Curfew successful: AP Governor

Vijayawada, March 21st: Andhra Pradesh Governor Sri Biswa Bhusan Harichandan sought the attention of people of Andhra Pradesh to follow 'Janata Curfew' on Sunday, 22nd March, from 7 AM to 9 PM by adhering to the call given by PM Sri Narendra Modi ji and make it successful. He appealed to the people of Andhra Pradesh to remain indoors from 7 AM to 9 PM on 22nd March, Sunday and not to venture outside. The Governor said this measure is meant essentially to curtail spread of Novel corona virus. He said a day's cooperation from the people may break the chain of spread of Novel corona virus.

The Governor urged the people not to move out of their homes on 22nd March. He also advised voluntary organisations, Red Cross and organisations led by youth like the NCC, Scouts and Guides, NSS, civil society and others to create awareness and encourage citizens to follow 'Janata Curfew' and stay inside their homes. The Governor said people should follow the advise of PM Modi and ensure that his message reaches everyone about the 'Janata Curfew' as well as about the measures needed to be taken to prevent spreading of Covid-19. The Governor also reminded about PM Modi's special request that while observing 'Janata Curfew' citizens should take part in thanking all the medical fraternity, who have been working day in and day out at hospitals and public places like railway stations, bus stations and airports. The Governor said it is the time for all the people to stand united and fight against the menace of novel corona virus which is posing a threat to the whole mankind.
