Avoid religious congregations, cooperate with medical staff: AP Governor appeals to religious leaders

Vijayawada, April 04: Andhra Pradesh Governor Sri Biswa Bhusan Harichandan gave an appeal to the religious leaders in the state to completely stop all forms of religious congregations and to issue an advisory to all the people of their faith to follow physical distancing and other guidelines issued by the Central and State Governments and support the administration in curbing the spread of Coronavirus. Covid - 19 poses a grave danger to the entire mankind and this danger can be averted only with the cooperation and collaboration of people belonging to all faiths in a united manner in accordance with the accepted health protocols.

The Governor said that people should extend solidarity with the frontline medical staff who are serving round the clock and help them discharge their duties effectively. Sri Harichandan said people should lend their support to the medical staff in conducting door to door surveillance, tracing, testing and isolation of affected persons and refrain from misbehaving or indulging in acts of violence against the medical staff, who are rendering service to the people by putting their lives at risk.
