Andhra Pradesh Governor contributes Rs.30 lakhs to CMRF from discretionary funds

Vijayawada, April 10: Andhra Pradesh Governor Sri Biswa Bhusan Harichandan has decided to contribute Rs.30 Lakhs to the AP Chief Minister's Relief Fund from the discretionary funds/grants available to meet expenditure of the Governor/Governor's Secretariat, under the budget allocated during the Financial year 2020-21.
