Trainee IAS officers meet AP Governor

Vijayawada, June 29: Trainee IAS officers of 2018 batch allotted to AP cadre, who were undergoing training in AP Secretariat, met Andhra Pradesh Governor Sri Biswa Bhusan Harichandan at Raj Bhavan on Monday. The second phase of their mandatory training programme at Mussoorie, was postponed by a month due to the corona virus pandemic. Meanwhile, the State government issued orders posting them in various departments in AP Secretariat, after completion of field training and it enabled them to learn various nuances of the public administration during this period.
