Governor Biswa Bhusan Harichandan appeals people to go for vaccination

- AP Governor Biswa Bhusan Harichandan pays tributes to Mahatma Jyotiba Phule on 195th Birth Anniversary

Vijayawada, April 11: Andhra Pradesh Governor Sri Biswa Bhusan Harichandan paid rich tributes to Mahatma Jyotiba Phule on the occasion of his 195th Birth anniversary at a programme held in Durbar Hall at Raj Bhavan on Sunday. Governor Sri Biswa Bhusan Harichandan offered floral tributes to the portrait of Mahatma Jyotiba Phule and said that Jyotiba Phule was a great social reformer who led the movement against caste restrictions in the country during the 19th century and fought for the rights of peasants and downtrodden people of the society.

Governor Sri Harichandan said Mahatma Jyotiba Phule was also a pioneer of women's education and was the first to establish an orphanage for under-privileged children and fought for emancipation of people that were subjected to social deprivation in those days. The Governor said Jyotiba Phule stood as an inspiration to leaders like Mahatma Gandhi and Dr. B.R. Ambedkar in the later years.

Speaking on the occasion, Governor Sri Harichandan appealed to the people of Andhra Pradesh to be very cautious about the prevailing situation of Covid-19 pandemic which has posed a great challenge not only to the country but entire humanity.
