RP Sisodia assumes charge as Spl. Chief Secretary to Governor

Vijayawada, August 23: Sri R.P. Sisodia has assumed charge as Special Chief Secretary to Governor at Raj Bhavan on Monday. Sri Sisodia met Governor Sri Biswa Bhusan Harichandan in his chambers, before assuming charge as Special Chief Secretary to Governor and later held a meeting with officers of the Raj Bhavan and enquired about duties and responsibilities of each officer. Sri R.P.
