Governor invited for 'Vigraha Pratishta' in temple constructed by TTD in Bhubaneswar

Vijayawada, May 9: Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam Chairman Sri Y.V. Subba Reddy visited Raj Bhavan on Monday and invited Andhra Pradesh Governor Sri Biswabhusan Harichandan to grace the occasion of 'Vigraha Pratishta' and 'Maha Samprokshana' ceremonies to be held at the temple of Sri Venkateswara Swami on May 26, newly constructed by the TTD in Bhubaneswar in Odisha.

Sri Subba Reddy informed Governor Sri Harichandan that the religious ceremonies connected with the installation of the idol of the deity will commence from May 21 and the 'Vigraha Pratishta' and 'Maha Samprokshana' will be held on May 26 and requested the Governor to grace the occasion.
