AP Chief Minister calls on Governor

Vijayawada, June 6: Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Sri Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy along with his wife Smt. Y.S. Bharathi Reddy, called on Andhra Pradesh Governor Sri Biswabhusan Harichandan and Lady Governor Smt. Suprava Harichandan at Raj Bhavan here on a courtesy visit on Monday.

Sri R.P. Sisodia, Special Chief Secretary to Governor welcomed Chief Minister Sri Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy, on his arrival at Raj Bhavan.

During the meeting, the Chief Minister has briefed Governor Sri Harichandan about various welfare schemes being implemented by the State govt. for the benefit of large number of people from weaker sections.
